Mathematics

This term, students will be given many hands-on opportunities to understand and explore:

- measurement
- probability

Building on previous knowledge of the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Specialists

All LSG classes will participate in specialist classes throughout the year including PE, STEM and Art.

Physical Education & Health

Students will be involved in regular P.E. sessions throughout the week that will focus on the fundamental motor skills. Our health focus will be on how we can be Sun Smart, why hydration is important and how healthy foods help our bodies and brains to grow and function.

English

Our explicit English program is progressing nicely with students engaging in activities focussed on reading, writing, spelling, comprehension, fluency and grammar skills. Through fun and predictable activities and tailored instruction, students have the opportunity to enhance their literacy skills across these domains.

The Arts

This term we will focus on visual arts. In visual arts lessons students will explore how and why artworks are created and ways to use and apply visual conventions, such as line, shape, colour and texture and learn how their ideas can be developed through forms, styles, techniques, materials and technologies.
