Mathematics

This term, students will be given many hands-on opportunities to understand and explore:

The Arts

This term we will participate in drama and visual arts activities. In Drama, they will explore voice and movement to act out simple books and scenarios. Students will participate in Visual Arts lessons both in the mainstream Kindergarten classroom and during specialist lessons. They will create pieces using a variety of media and techniques to communicate their ideas to an audience.



English

Our explicit English program is progressing nicely. Students are engaging in activities focussed on reading, writing, spelling, comprehension, fluency and grammar skills. Through fun and predictable activities and tailored instruction, students have the opportunity to enhance their literacy skills across these domains.
